## 2012 CSA Agreement

Dear CSA Members,

To help our CSA program run smoothly, please read and sign this agreement. Allandale Farm promises to deliver to you the freshest produce possible, on the day of your choosing, during the hours assigned. To ensure receipt of the proper share, please adhere to these times. All CSA shares will be handed out in the barn behind the farm stand. The morning of your pick-up, the vegetables are harvested and rinsed before being packed and refrigerated. Because we harvest the day of the pick-up, we must have you adhere to the pick-up times, especially during the heavy harvest season of summer.

Parking for CSA pick-up is in the main parking lot only. This is because of entering deliveries, farm vehicles, and the safety of our Outdoor Summer Program children and employees. In order for the lines in our barn and at our register to move as quickly as possible, we ask that you designate one name to each share. In the event that someone besides you comes to Allandale to pick up your share, they need only to know the name assigned to the share. Every unclaimed share will be donated to Lovin' Spoonfuls ([www.lovinspoonfuldinc.org](http://www.lovinspoonfuldinc.org)) the Friday of each week at 10 am. There is no need to contact us if you cannot pick up your share.

We will be packing shares in the same containers as past years: wax-covered cardboard boxes. The boxes this year will be a more environmentally friendly box than in years past. These boxes are very expensive, but re-useable. Because of all the people who brought their boxes back to the farm on a weekly basis, we were able to keep our costs down, and help the environment. We ask that you bring your folded box back to the farm to be used the following week. These boxes are easy to disassemble when you know the trick, please don't be shy about asking, as a ripped box has a short life. Furthermore, feel free to bring your own box or bag to pick-up, and we can transfer the produce on the spot.
